



SIZES:

Width approx. 47-62 cm. Length approx. 52-80 cm.

MATERIALS:

WENDY DK WITH WOOL 5307 COLOR

KNITTING TENSION:

17 stitches in width and 30 rows in height, with pattern A.1 and 1 strand of each quality = 10 x 10 cm.

NEEDLES:

CIRCULAR NEEDLE SIZE 4.5 MM: Length 60 cm or 80 cm.

Needle size is only a guide. If you get too many stitches on 10 cm, change to a larger needle size. If you get too few stitches on 10 cm, change to a smaller needle size.

EXPLANATIONS FOR THE PATTERN:

RIDGE/GARTER STITCH (worked back and forth):

Knit all rows.

1 ridge in height = Knit 2 rows.

PATTERN:

See diagram A.1. The diagram shows all rows in the pattern from the right side.

START THE PIECE HERE:

BLANKET:

Cast on 80-106 stitches with circular needle size 4.5 mm and 1 strand and 1 strand Kid-Silk (= 2 strands).

Work 2 RIDGES – read description above.

Now work pattern as follows:

1 edge stitch in garter stitch, work A.1 until there is 1 stitch left and 1 edge stitch in garter stitch.

Continue back and forth like this. REMEMBER THE KNITTING TENSION!

When the piece measures 52-80 cm – adjust so there is 1 row left in the diagram, cast off with knit from the wrong side.

Diagram

☐ = knit from right side, purl from wrong side

☐ = knit from wrong side

☐☐ = between 2 stitches make 1 yarn over. On the next row knit the yarn over – leaves a hole

☐☐ = knit 2 together
