



Pattern mb-002-by Yarn group C

MATERIALS: WENDY SUPREME DK WD47 COLOR

KNITTING TENSION: 17 stitches in width and 22 rows vertically in stocking stitch = 10×10 cm

NEEDLES: CIRCULAR NEEDLE SIZE 5 mm: length 60 or 80 cm. CABLE NEEDLE - for cables. Needle size is only a suggestion! If you have too many stitches on 10 cm switch to a larger needle size. If you have too few stitches on 10 cm switch to a smaller needle size.

EXPLANATION FOR THE PATTERN:

GARTER STITCH (back and forth): 1 ridge = knit 2 rows.

PATTERN: See diagrams A.1 and A.2.

START THE PIECE HERE:

BLANKET – SHORT OVERVIEW OF THE PIECE: Work piece back and forth on circular needle.

BLANKET:

Cast on 68-116 stitches on circular needle size 5 mm with. Work 2 ridges in GARTER STITCH - read explanation above. Work next row as follows from right side: 2 stitches in garter stitch, A.1 over the next 64-112 stitches (= 8-14 repetitions of 8 stitches), finish with 2 stitches in garter stitch. When A.1 has been worked 1 time vertically, there are 84-144 stitches on needle. Work next row as follows from right side: 2 stitches in garter stitch, A.2 over the next 80-140 stitches (= 8-14 repetitions of 10 stitches), finish with 2 stitches in garter stitch. REMEMBER THE KNITTING TENSION! Continue pattern like this. When piece measures 48-78 cm, decrease 2 stitches over each cable = 68-116 stitches. Work 2 ridges, then cast off.

Diagram

- \square = knit from the right side, purl from the wrong side
- **⊠**= purl from the right side, knit from the wrong side
- = between 2 stitches make 1 yarn over, on next row purl yarn over twisted to make avoid holes

= slip 3 stitches on cable needle in front of piece, knit 3, knit 3 from cable needle
