Knitting Needles:

1 Pair of 2.75mm Knitting Needles.
1 Pair of 3mm Knitting Needles.
1 Pair of 4mm Knitting Needles.
Stuffing.
Oddments of Black DK for embroidery.

Tension:

Teddy

26sts to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using **3.25mm (US3) needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.

Dress

22sts and 28 rows over stocking stitch ad 22sts and 36 rows over garter stitch using **4mm needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirement and are therefore approximate.

VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

Abbreviations

alt alternate, **cont** continue, **K** Knit, **P** Purl, **psso** pass slipped stitch over, **rep** repeat,
rem remain(ing), **rs** right side, **s1** slip one stitch knitways, **st(s)** stitch(es), **ws** wrong side, **tog** together.

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MINI TEDDY

BODY

Commencing at lower edge

Using **2.75mm needles and A** cast on 10sts.

1st Row: Inc in 1st st, (inc in next st) 9 times. 20sts.

2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Inc in 1st st, K1, (inc in next st, K1) 9 times. 30sts.

5th Row: Inc in 1st st, K1, (inc in next st, K1) 14 times.

45sts.

Commencing with a purl row work 15 rows in st-st.

Next Row: K14, K2tog, (K2, K2tog) 4 times, K13. 40sts.

Commencing with a purl row work 13 rows in st-st.

Next Row: (K1, K2tog) 13 times, K1. 27sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog, K1) 9 times. 18sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog, K1) 6 times. 12sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog) 6 times. 6sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

Placing seam to back fold cast on edge in half and join seam.

Join back seam leaving sufficient space to stuff.

Stuff firmly.

Join remainder of seam.

Embroider pumpkin face using **B** as illustrated.

HEAD

Commencing at Muzzle

Muzzle.

Using **2.75mm needles and B**, cast on 10sts.

1st Row: Knit to end, inc in 1st, 2nd, 5th, 8th and 9th sts. 15sts.

2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit to end, inc in 2nd, 3rd, 8th, 13th and 14th stitches. 20sts.

5th Row: Knit to end, inc in 1st, 2nd, 10th, 18th and 19th stitches. 25sts.

7th Row: Knit to end, inc in 2nd, 3rd, 13th, 23rd and 24th stitches. 30sts.

8th Row: Purl.

Cast off.

Main Part.

With rs of Muzzle facing and using **C**, pick up and knit 30sts from cast off sts.

Next Row: P5, (inc in next st purlways) 8 times, P4, (inc in next st purlways) 8 times, P5. 46sts.

Next Row: K20, inc in next st, K4, inc in next st, K20. 48sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K20, inc in next st, K6, inc in next st, K20. 50sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K20, inc in next st, K8, inc in next st, K20. 52sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K20, inc in next st, K10, inc in next st, K20. 54sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Inc in 1st st, knit to last 2sts, inc in next st, K1. 56sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 58sts.

Work 2 rows more in st-st.

Next Row: (K2, K2tog) 6 times, K10, (K2tog, K2) 6 times. 46sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, (K1, K2tog) 6 times, K8, (K2tog, K1) 6 times, K1. 34sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog) 17 times. 17sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, (K2tog) 8 times. 9sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

Gather cast on edge of muzzle, draw up and fasten off.

Placing seam to back join back seam leaving sufficient space to stuff. Stuff firmly. Join remainder of seam. Using oddments of yarn embroider face as illustrated.

EARS (Make 2)

Using 2.75mm needles and B, cast on 8sts and work 2 rows in st-st.

Next Row: S1, K1, pssso, K4, K2tog. 6sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: S1, K1, pssso, K2, K2tog. 4sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Cast off.

ARMS (Both Alike)

Using 2.75mm needles and B, cast on 7sts.

1st Row: Inc in 1st st, inc into each of next 5sts, K1. 13sts.

2nd Row: Purl.

Working in 2 rows of **C** and 2 rows of **B**, work 18 rows in st-st.

Next Row: K1, (K2tog, K1) 4 times. 9sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog) 4 times, K1. 5sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off. Join side seams leaving sufficient space to stuff. Stuff firmly. Join remainder of seam.

LEGS (Both Alike)

Commencing at Sole.

Using 2.75mm needles and B, cast on 7sts.

1st Row: Inc in 1st st, K1, inc into each of next 2sts, K1, inc in next st, K1. 11sts.

2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Inc in 1st st, K2, inc into each of next 4sts, K2, inc in next st, K1. 17sts.

5th Row: Inc in 1st st, K5, inc into each of next 4sts, K5, inc in next st, K1. 23sts.

Commencing with a purl row work 5 rows in st-st.

Next Row: K6, (K2tog) 6 times, K5. 17sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K7, (K2tog) twice, K6. 15sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Working in 2 rows of **C** and 2 rows of **B**, work 16 rows in st-st inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 8th row. 19sts.

Next row: K1, (K2tog, K1) 6 times. 13sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog) 6 times, K1. 7sts.

Next row: Purl.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off. Join Sole, Foot and Leg seam leaving sufficient space to stuff. Stuff firmly. Join remainder of seam.

TO MAKE UP

Gather cast on edge of Ears gently to form a slight curve and attach one to each side of Head. Attach Head to Body then insert needle into and out of a very small section of the Head (2sts wide) then the Body and working round in a spiral,

continue until Head is attached firmly to Body. Fasten off securely. Sew Arms to Body by inserting needle into inside edge at top of Arm, pass needle through Body into the top edge of second Arm, then back to the first Arm. Repeat until Arms feel secure and fasten off. Sew Legs to Body in same way.

LARGE PUMPKIN

Using 3mm needles and A, cast on 9sts.

1st Row: Knit into Front and Back of each st. 18sts.

2nd Row: Knit.

3rd Row: K1, knit into Front and Back of next 16sts, K1. 34sts.

4th Row: Knit.

5th Row: K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

6th Row: *P2, K2, rep from* to last 2sts, P2.

Rep last 2 rows 9 times more.

25th Row: *K2, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2. 18sts.

26th Row: Knit.

27th Row: (K2tog) 9 times. 9sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts and fasten off.

STALK

Using 3mm needles and C, cast on 12sts.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam stuffing firmly as you go. Fold Stalk in half and secure to Pumpkin by sewing through top of Pumpkin to bottom of Pumpkin to create a dimple.

SMALL PUMPKIN

Using 3mm needles and A, cast on 6sts.

1st Row: Knit into Front and Back of each st. 12sts.

2nd Row: Knit.

3rd Row: K1, knit into Front and Back of next 10sts, K1. 22sts.

4th Row: Knit.

5th Row: *K2, knit into Front and Back of next st, rep from * to last st, K1. 29sts.

6th Row: Knit to end.

7th Row: K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

8th Row: *P2, K2, rep from* to last st, P1.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more.

19th Row: *K2, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1. 22sts.

20th Row: Knit.

21st Row: K1, (K2tog) 10 times, K1. 12sts.

22nd Row: Knit.

23rd Row: (K2tog) 6 times. 6sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts and fasten off.

STALK

Using 3mm needles and C, cast on 12sts.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam stuffing firmly as you go. Fold Stalk in half and secure to Pumpkin by sewing through top of Pumpkin to bottom of Pumpkin to create a dimple.

DRESS FOR BIG TEDDY

Big Teddy pattern available as separate download.

Worked in one piece to armholes with back opening

Using 4mm needles and Yarn D, cast on 88sts and knit 4 rows.

Working in g-st and Stripes of 2 rows in **Yarn B** and 2 rows in **Yarn D**, work 8 rows.

Next Row: Using Yarn B, K5, K2tog, (K3, K2tog) 15 times, K6. 72sts.

Work 7 rows more.

Next Row: Using Yarn B, K5, K2tog, (K2, K2tog) 15 times, K5. 56sts.

Work 7 rows more.

Break off Yarn D.

Using Yarn B only, work 2 rows in st-st.

Shape Raglans.

Next Row: K12 leave these 12sts on needle for Left Back, cast

off 4sts, K23 leave these 24sts on needle for Front, cast off 4sts, knit to end.

With ws facing, continue to work on first 12sts for Right Back as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row (rs): K2tog, knit to end. 11sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 6sts.

Leave these 6sts on a stitch holder for Neckband.

With ws facing, rejoin **Yarn B** to centre 24sts left on a stitch holder for Front and purl to end.

Next Row: K2tog, knit to last 2sts, K2tog. 22sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 10sts.

Leave these 10sts on a stitch holder for Neckband.

With ws facing rejoin **Yarn B** to rem 12sts left on a stitch holder for Left Back and proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Knit to last 2sts, K2tog. 11sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 6sts.

Leave these 6sts on a stitch holder for Neckband.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 4mm needles and Yarn D, cast on 26sts and knit 4 rows.

Working in g-st and Stripes of 2 rows in **Yarn B** and 2 rows in **Yarn D**, work 16 rows.

Break off Yarn D.

Using Yarn B only, commencing with a knit row and working in st-st (throughout) work 2 rows.

Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows. 22sts.

Next Row: K2tog, knit to last 2sts, K2tog. 20sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 10sts.

Leave these 10sts on a stitch holder for Neckband.

NECKBAND

Join raglan seams. With rs facing **using 3.25mm needles and Yarn D**, knit across 6sts left on a stitch holder for Left Back, knit across 10sts left on a stitch holder for Left Sleeve as follows:

(K2tog) 5 times, knit across 12sts left on a stitch holder for Front, knit across 10sts left on a stitch holder for Right Sleeve as follows: (K2tog) 5 times and knit across 6sts left on a stitch holder for Right Back. 34sts.

Knit 3 rows.

Cast off.

LEFT BACK BORDER

With rs facing, **using 3mm needles** pick up and knit 31sts evenly along back edge from cast on edge to cast off edge of Neckband.

Knit 4 rows.

Cast off.

RIGHT BACK BORDER

Work as given for Left Back Border, picking up in reverse.

TO MAKE UP

Join Sleeve seams. Sew on 4 press studs to Left/Right Back Border. Pin out garment and leave under a damp cloth for 24 hours. **Using Yarn D** embroider BOO onto Front as shown in photograph.
